The Senior Pastor's Paragraph to the CHUM Family

Hopefully you remember that church leadership, following dialogue with our Generis consultant and the Mission and Outreach Team, made the conscious decision to include all church fund raising within the Embrace umbrella—with one major exception: Panguma Scholarships. CHUM annually raises about \$35,000 to provide scholarships for students at the Camp Hill UMC International Preschool in Panguma, the Panguma UMC Primary School and Panguma UMC Secondary School (junior and senior high school). We also provide a handful of scholarships to teachers in those institutions who have not yet completed their educational requirements. (*Once they have fulfilled all their educational requirements as teachers, the government of Sierra Leone is supposed to pay their salaries!*) As Embrace was being formulated, it was agreed that CHUM would continue to fund the Panguma Scholarship Project in the same way we have done in the past, and that's why folks were asked to include all giving on the Embrace Commitment Card EXCEPT Panguma Scholarship funds. The month of June at CHUM will be dedicated to our annual Panguma Scholarship Drive. Stay tuned for more in coming weeks!
